She began her banking career in 1966 at Home Federal in Bishopville. She stayed with banking through several mergers, retiring in January of 2007 with First Palmetto Bank. She enjoyed bookkeeping and kept the books for Triple K Farms. She worked with the Lee County Clerk of Court, bookkeeping records from August 2007 until 2010. She enjoyed working in her yard.

She is survived by her sons, John Brewer Kelly of Bishopville, SC, Russell Denny Kelly of Bishopville, SC; daughter, Cynthia Ann Kelly Davis (Mark) of Bishopville, SC; brother, Ed Turner of Bishopville, SC; grandchildren, Kelly Ann Davis (Sarah) of Camden, SC, Nolan A.
