It is with deep sorrow that the Strickland family announces the death of Ms. Anne Elizabeth "Beth" Strickland, 74.

Ms. Strickland entered into rest on Monday, June 3, 2024. The family will conduct a memorial service at 2:00 pm on Sunday, June 23rd, 2024, at Bethlehem United Methodist Church. The family will receive friends at a visitation in the Fellowship Hall, and the burial will be private.

You could hand her a gardening tool or a hand mixer, and Beth would make something amazing out of either. Beth also loved fishing. She cherished the times when she was able to go pier fishing at the beach. You could always find her on the pier from sunup to sunset fishing. When you think of Beth, imagine her sitting at the pier fishing for that “one fish” she planned to cook for supper, with that smile on her that everyone remembers. Beth will be missed by her family and friends.

She is survived by her loving brother, James Leslie “Jim” Strickland, and his wife, Jackie of Elgin, SC; 8 nieces and nephews, 13 great nieces and nephews, and 2 great-great nephews.
