Ernest David Thigpen, Sr., loving husband of Mary Tomlinson Thigpen, passed away peacefully at his home on May 23, 2026, surrounded by his family at the age of 83.

A funeral service to honor his life will be held at 2 o'clock on Tuesday, May 26, 2026, at First Baptist Church in Bishopville, with The Rev. Jed Bryant officiating the service. The family will receive friends in the First Baptist Church Fellowship Hall immediately following the service and at other times at the residence.
