



Mr. George Rembert Beasley Sr.

February 2, 1944 - May 26, 2017

Funeral services for Mr. George Rembert Beasley Sr., 73, who died peacefully on Friday, May 26, 2017, will be held at 11 o'clock on Monday, May 29, 2017, at St. Luke United Methodist Church, Elliott, SC.
