



Mr. Guerry Lynn Driggers

September 28, 1954 - December 22, 2025

It is with deep sorrow that Mrs. Janet Fraser Driggers and her family announce the death of her beloved husband, Mr. Guerry Lynn Driggers, 71.

Mr. Driggers entered into rest on Monday, December 22, 2025. The Directors of Hancock-Elmore-Hill Funeral Home are caring for the family.

A funeral service to honor his life will be held at 1 o'clock on Sunday, December 28, 2025, in First Baptist Church of Bishopville. The Rev. Jed Bryant will officiate, and the family will receive friends in the Fellowship Hall immediately following the service. A private family burial will be held at Cades Pentecostal Holiness Church in Cades, SC.

Mr. Driggers was born on Tuesday, September 28, 1954, in Kingstree, SC, and grew up in Hogeye Crossroads. He is the son of the late Ernest Truluck Driggers and the late Roberta Matthews Driggers. Guerry Driggers was a man of God. He was a man of faith. He grew up in the Hogeye Crossroads Community near Cades, SC. If given the chance, Guerry would quickly tell you that Hogeye was "A little piece of Heaven on Earth" that he loved dearly.

In 1972, Guerry graduated with honors from Hebron High School in Cades. He then attended Holmes Bible College in Greenville, SC, to pursue a calling from God to preach the Gospel of his Lord and Savior. Guerry served as a minister for a number of years in several North Carolina and South Carolina Pentecostal Holiness Churches. He always remained true to the Pentecostal Holiness doctrine, even though in later years he attended a Baptist church. Guerry was still a Reverend with the SC Pentecostal Holiness Conference when he passed.

For the past several years, Guerry faithfully attended First Baptist Church of Bishopville. He was very fondly known as a "Bapti-Costal" by his church family there. He served as a Sunday school teacher, served on several church committees, and sometimes held special Bible studies. Guerry played guitar and sang beautifully, as well as wrote numerous gospel songs. He blessed his church family with this talent as often as he could be persuaded. Guerry was also a "go-to" with Biblical questions as he could quote much scripture from memory.

Guerry was never an idle man. If he wasn't reading or studying God's word, he was tinkering in the garage and always fixing something. Unlike most, he loved doing yard work. Everything Guerry approached, he did so to the absolute best of his ability.

Guerry was a kind, quiet, and humble man. Though generally considered a "Man of few words," he could be a total cut-up and talk your ears off if he got to know you. If you didn't have that opportunity, it was truly your loss.

"Papa G," as known by his grandchildren, loved his family beyond anyone's understanding. But, as much as he loved them, he loved his Lord more! Though he will be missed terribly, there is no doubt in his family's mind where Guerry is now. He is HAPPY! He is HOME! There will never be another like

him! He was truly a special man!

He is survived by his loving wife, Janet Fraser Driggers; son, Charles Nathaniel "Nathan" (Nikki) Driggers, William N. (Cher) Boyce III, Clinton F.
