Isabelle Bailey McCutchen, widow of Luther Oliver McCutchen died on Saturday, December 8, 2018, at the age of 91.

She was born on July 18, 1927 in Summerville, SC, and was the daughter of Charles Ernest Bailey and Ruth Rowell Bailey. Isabelle graduated from Summerville High School and from Brenau College, when she was a member of Delta Delta Delta sorority. 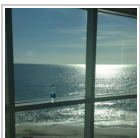
