She loved her job doing phlebotomy for McLeod Hospital, Pee Dee Cardiology, and both Dr. Siti's in Florence, SC. She stepped in many times when family members needed bloodwork or had trouble with bad veins. She also loved her time at BlueCross BlueShield in Columbia, SC.

Her family, as well as her neighbors at Woods Edge, have loved and enjoyed her talents and creativity for years. She loved anything arts and crafts and could turn anything into something. She decorated the halls and any flat surface she could find. Jennifer cared for many of the residents in her building and was their go-to person if anything was needed.

She will be missed not only by her family, friends, and coworkers but by her service dog, Penelope as well. Penelope was with her for only a short time, as it took some time for her to grieve for Kai, who took care of her for many years.

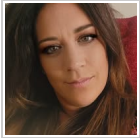
