as every continent. After Gerry's death in 2018, Betty returned home to Shannon Hill, in Bishopville, SC. She loved Bishopville and living in her family home place until her health would no longer allow her to live alone.

Betty was active in many organizations throughout her life and teaching career. She was a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution, Colonial Dames, and the Huguenot Society. Betty was a member of the First Baptist Church of Bishopville and the Kudsens Sunday School.
