Mary was a selfless giver and loved everyone. As a member of Bethlehem United Methodist Church, she was a Sunday school teacher (Young Adult class named in her honor), served as chairperson of the Administrative Board, and the Council of Ministries; delegate to the Annual Conference; president of the Women of the Church; and member of the Pastor-Parish Relationship Committee. She received the Converse 100 Award in 2006 for her selfless giving to her community. Her greatest joy was spending time with her family and friends and sharing the love of Jesus Christ.
