In addition to her father, she was preceded in death by her son, Cole Younger Johnson.

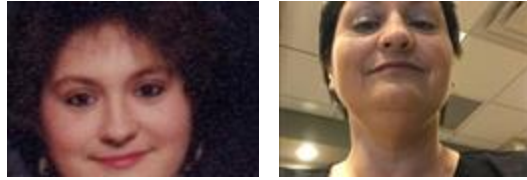

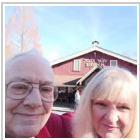
