Mrs. Nell Broadway Baker, 91, went to be with her heavenly Lord on Monday, July 29, 2019, after a thirteen-year battle with Alzheimer's. Funeral services will be held at 3 o'clock on Saturday, August 3, 2019, in The Chapel of Hancock-Elmore-Hill Funeral Home. The Rev. Nat Brown will officiate followed by a brief graveside service in the Cedar Creek Baptist Church Cemetery.
