



## Mr. Robert Eugene Webber

May 12, 1930 - March 27, 2018

Robert Eugene Webber, affectionally known as “Bob a Louie”, 87, passed away March 27th, 2018, at Florida Hospital Flagler in Palm Coast, Florida. He was born in the family home near Stockport, Iowa on May 12th, 1930 to the late Ray Ellsworth Webber and Ona Crawford Webber.

After growing up on a grain and dairy farm in Iowa, his adult life consisted of moving to different farms around the southeast that were in financial trouble and making them profitable again.
