



Mr. Wade "Bubba" Green

Funeral services for Mr. Wade Aiken "Bubba" Green, Sr., 72, who died peacefully on Friday, December 8, 2017, will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, December 13, 2017 at Bethlehem United Methodist Church, Bishopville, SC.
